# POS AND JOB COSTING

## POINT OF SALES

POS (Point of Sales) is a feature through which we can create an Invoice at a point of sales, and collect the payment from the customers. POS Invoice is generated when a customer is making purchase in person and the process of checking is part of it.

### CREATION OF POS INVOICE VOUCHER TYPE

#### I. WITHOUT VOUCHER CLASS

- 1) Gate way of Tally
- 2) Account's Info
- 3) Voucher Type
- 4) Create
- 5) Name = POS Invoice
- 6) Type of voucher = Sales
- 7) Use for POS Invoicing = Yes
- 8) Print Message 1 = Thank You!
- 9) Print Message 2 = Visit Us Again!

#### II. WITH VOUCHER CLASS

- 1) Name of Class = POS.
- 2) Give the particular from the statement given below:

#### Note:

- (a) Select Single Payment/Multi Payment from Button Panel
- (b) Single Payment: Cash
- (c) Multi Payment: Timex Gift Voucher = 1200; VISA Card = 1300; Canara Bank = 600; Cash=?
- (d) Cash Tendered by customer Rs.2000.

## COST CENTRE

Cost Centre is useful to find out the classified expenses or incomes of different Cost Centre like Purchase Department, Sales Department, Production Department, etc

### ACTIVATION:

1. Press F11: Features
2. Accounting Features
3. Maintain Cost Centres = "YES"

### **Post the following transactions:**

12.04.2006	Salary Paid Rs. 200000: Purchases Department 30%; Sales Department 40%; Production Department 30%.
15.05.2006	Electricity Charges Paid Rs. 30000: Purchases Department 25%; Sales Department 35%; Production Department 40%.
18.07.2006	Telephone Charges Rs. 12000; Purchases Department 30%; Sales Department 35%; Production Department 35%.
30.08.2006	Commission Received Rs.6000; Purchases Department 40%; Sales Department 40%; Production Department 20%.
05.09.2006	Discount Received Rs. 4000; Purchases Department 40%; Sales Department 40%; Production Department 20%.

## JOB COSTING

Job Costing feature is useful to find out the cost and revenue of a particular job or project to the smallest level. Costs associated with the planning, implementation and completion of a project or job are known as Job costs

### ACTIVATION

1. Press F11: Features
2. Maintain Cost Centers = "YES"
3. Use Cost Centre for Job Costing = "YES"
4. While Ledger creation, Cost Centers are applicable? = "YES"
